### Delivering the Wynyard Waterfront

The transformative upgrade to the Wynyard Waterfront will be delivered by the Liberal National Government.

The \$3.2 million Building Better Regions Fund grant has been approved and will completely revitalise the way Wynyard interacts with the beautiful Inglis River.
